Some of the people who make decisions about health and care services will be at the meeting.



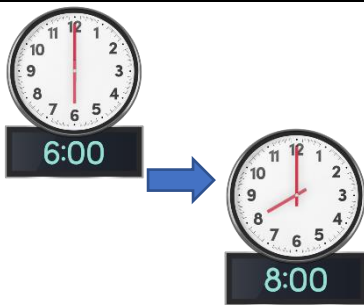
They will listen to what the problems are.



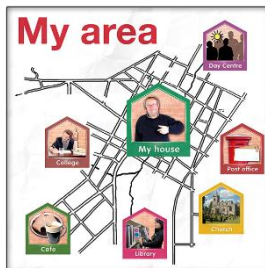
There will be British Sign Language Interpreters at the meeting

It starts at 6pm and finishes at 8pm

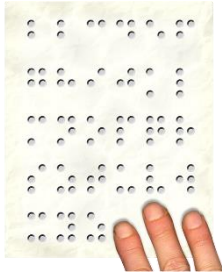

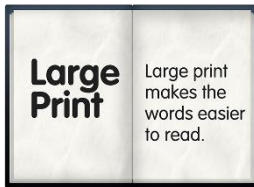
