2) People with Learning Disabilities and/or Autism and Carers, saying...

Changing Doctors

MM said after negative experiences has changed which doctors registered with. Said not be afraid to switch if having poor service, as very easy, simple process.



Digital Exclusion

PC not on internet, very hard to contact Bretton Doctors Surgery. Can't get through on phone (after 30mins still 7th to 4th in que). Booking appointments by walking in.



NHS Dentists

MM asked what to do if not registered at dentists and need to see one? GL said NHS 111 will advise what is available: surgeries seeing new patients or access to emergency services. This Healthwatch gave Government NHS dentist report.

- ✓ For Autism Awareness week had stall in Peterborough City Hospital. Asked for hospital improvements ideas for people with autism.

New Free Photo I.D for Voting

✓ Telling people why need ID to vote now and how to get Free ID online from the Council if did not have a passport, driving license, blue badge or disabled person's bus pass.

Local Elections Engagement Meeting

Good meeting with council leaders. Lots of questions asked, including:

- **Q** How can people with a learning disability get Photo ID if don't know how to go online?
- **Q** Why are the bus services so bad and what would you do about it?
- Q Cuts in care for people with learning disability and autism and their family carers – What would you do?
- Q Pavement parking and poor pavements - What would you do?

- Peterborough City Hospital admissions. Learning disability info added to notes once, then stays on notes for future admissions. Nurses don't support outpatient appointments or A&E patients.

✓ Advised people at Prospects Trust Unwrapped in Ely. Visited Facet and Tennyson Lodge Asked people what good day opportunity should look like?


World Down Syndrome Day - London

✓ Helping improve Council Contact Form.








Russell Henke – High Supports Needs **Histon and Impington Wellbeing Festival**

Research asking parents with learning disabilities how supported by local authority when their children are no longer in their care. To make improve support.










