ACTION: Jill Johnson will pass feedback to comms about easy read and look into LDPB mailing list.










What we have to say... Debbie Dentist Cancellations

Michelle got emergency dentist appointment given temporary filling, told long wait for permanent filling appointment (still got toothache).










What we have to say... Debbie Meeting Notice too short

- Adult Health Committee wanting to involve people with learning disabilities to come and talk about ways to improve peoples health.
- A few weeks is not enough notice given to get people with lived experience involved.





What we have to say... Travis Concessionary Bus Passes

- Helen Bus drivers still not letting people on with passes from 9.30am when they should.
- Since Combined Authority took over, process is more complicated.
- Told to go to libraries, but many libraries don't have staff or are able to do it.
- Rude service on the phone, given wrong information and no easy read paperwork.









What we have to say...

Concessionary Bus Passes Service

Difficulty getting new/ replacement bus passes is affecting peoples ability to get to health/ social services needed.



ACTION: Health Subgroup talk about how hard it is to get a letter from doctor for bus pass.

ACTION: Invite Metro Mayor Nick Johnson (will want to listen with voting coming up).

ACTION: GL to invite Combined Authority to April meeting.




Health Service Future...

Focusing on...


- Cardiovascular Disease (including heart attacks, strokes, high blood pressure, colesteral etc).
- Everything to do with keeping heart healthy and making sure you can live a healthy life for as long as possible.

Project Starts in 2024...

- Using lots of data, will be trying to find and identify people in the community who have early conditions that heart health isn't as healthy as could be.
- Will then contact them and get them into healthcare for treatment and supportive services.

Q What do people think about this?

- ✓ Annual Health Checks and Health Action Plans don't focus much on heart health, so this work is needed.
- ✓ Important to educate people with learning disabilities about the symptoms, what is normal, what is not, what to do if think something isn't normal etc.

Q How to make this accessible to people with learning disabilities?

✓ To get a better response, personalise approach so people receive it in the way they want.



> Technology not suitable to all, many struggle with emails/ scams.



> (Easy Read) letters more official and can show to others if not sure.

Q How explain what doing and importance of it?

- ✓ Use Social Media to say letters are coming soon, so people know its not a scam.
- ✓ Put a positive spin on message like 'to live healthier for longer'. If its too scary people wont respond.
- Get organisations like Healthwatch to share, so people know its real.


